

Dear Students,

Obuda University announces a scholarship for the first semester of the 2026/27 academic year for students enrolled in any programme and studying under any working schedule.

The scholarship is open to students with active status at Obuda University **who have a child in their care, and are either:**

- receiving infant care allowance (CSED), or
- receiving childcare benefit (GYES), or
- receiving child-raising support (GYET), or
- receiving childcare allowance (GYED)

The eligibility requirements for the scholarship are:

- **active student status in the first semester of the 2026/27 academic year,**
- **proof of eligibility with a document issued by a Hungarian authority.**
- **Applicants must submit the “OE-0083 - Declaration for applying for a scholarship related to the use of child care benefits” form in the NEPTUN system.**

The deadline for submission is **September 30, 2026.**

The amount of the scholarship is **10,000 HUF**, which is expected to be paid in November 2026. The deadline for the decision on the application is **October 15, 2026.**

In the case of infant care allowance (CSED), childcare benefit (GYES), childcare allowance (GYED), and child-rearing support (GYET), eligibility must be certified with a certificate or decision issued by the authority disbursing the support (local branches of the Hungarian State Treasury or government offices).

The document must contain the following information:

- the name and personal identification data of the student (place and date of birth, mother's name),
- the fact that the applicant is entitled to infant care allowance (CSED) or childcare allowance (GYED) or childcare benefit (GYES) or child-raising support (GYET) on February 1st, 2026.
