Who finances higher education studies?

Programmes provided by higher education institutions have costs. These costs can be paid to the institution either by the student, or – in the case of students holding a Hungarian State Grant – by the Hungarian state.

How is the Hungarian State Grant awarded?

Upon enrolment, students have to declare that they fulfil the conditions of the Grant. By doing so, the student becomes a holder of the Grant.



What is meant by the financing through the Hungarian State Grant?

The Hungarian state bears the costs of the studies of students with the Hungarian State Grant – for which students have to fulfil certain conditions.

What conditions shall be fulfilled for the Hungarian State Grant?

- 1 Students must obtain their diploma within the period that is one and a half times longer than the duration of their programme.
- Within 20 years after obtaining the diploma students must maintain an employment relationship (or any other work-related legal relationship) for at least the length of the duration of their programme.

What happens if a student does not fulfil the requirements?

There are sanctions stipulated by law, but there are also various possibilities for inquiries.

Do the requirements apply to all?

In some special cases, stipulated by law, by which the student – upon request – may become exempt from fulfilling the requirements.
